
#### **Latest Books Published in March!**

# **Artsy Fun - How to Eat Hot Pot**



What is hot pot?

Hot pot is a dish of soup/stock simmered with a heat source to cook meats and vegetables by dip-boiling in the liquid.

It's a great meal because you can customize with any meat, carb or vegetables! In modern times, people can have individual hot pots instead of sharing a communal hot pot.

In Toronto there are many, many, hot pot restaurants due to the large Asian population in the city. They all differ slightly, but the idea of boiling food is the same. Some are buffets, others weigh your bowl or you pay per item (meat, veggies, etc). Since it's a relatively easy meal to prepare, if you visit the Asian grocery store, you can buy the soup stock yourself along with frozen ingredients (meat, fish balls) and fresh ingredients (tofu, vegetables) to prepare your own meal.

Although the weather is getting warmer, I still love having hot pot. In this video I share my experience at Souper, one of the more newer hot pot restaurants in Toronto which has massive fridges filled with ingredients to select from!




